WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device by web sites that you visit or by clicking on a link to a site within an email. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to website owners.

The law states that where cookies are essential for the operation of our website, we can store these cookies on your device without your consent. For all other types of cookies, we need your permission.

SM	c.clarity.ms	Registers a unique ID that identifies the user's device during return visits across websites that use the same ad network. The ID is used to allow targeted ads.	session	Non-essential, analytics
MUID	clarity.ms	Bing sets this cookie to recognize unique web browsers visiting Microsoft sites. This cookie is used for advertising, site analytics, and other operations.	1 year 24 days	Advertisement
SRM_B	c.bing.com	Used by Microsoft Advertising as a unique ID for visitors.	1 year 24 days	Performance
ANONCHK	c.clarity.ms	The ANONCHK cookie, set by Bing, is used to store a user's session ID and also verify the clicks from ads on the Bing search engine. The cookie helps in reporting and personalization as well.	10 minutes	Advertisement
_pk_id.1.b469	matomo	This cookie is installed by Matomo. The cookie is used to calculate visitor, session, campaign data and keep track of site usage for the site's analytics report.
